2. Important Notices

Student VISA (D-2-8)	All foreign visiting students need to obtain D-2-8 visa for their studies at Hanyang before entering Korea. D-2-8 visa is a single-entry visa and it will be valid only for 90 days after student's arrival in Korea. * Students on different types of visa, excluding F type visas, will have to leave Korea to obtain D-2-8 visa. Therefore, students should apply for a "Residence Card (RC)" to extend their stay to complete the program and to allow themselves to travel outside of Korea if needed. • <u>Before arrival</u> in Korea: Need to apply for D-2-8 visa • <u>After arrival</u> in Korea: Need to apply for a Residence Card with the proper visa - MUST be registered within 90 days after arrival - Until you receive your RC, you CANNOT leave Korea - Leaving Korea during application process will result in CANCELLATION of visa and the program - Studying in Korea without RC is illegal
Accommodations	We are pleased to inform you that a newly constructed dormitory, also conveniently located near the campus is available for our exchange and visiting students. Students may also choose to arrange their own accommodations. We will provide a list of possible accommodations that have received positive reviews from past international students for reference. National Health Insurance	All international students in Korea are automatically registered for the National Health Insurance Service (NHIS) once they apply for their Residence Card. While highly recommended, NHIS coverage is not mandatory for all international students. - Students staying less than six months (one semester) may apply for an exemption. - Students staying over six months are required to enroll and pay the monthly premium. * All students are required to have their private insurance/travel insurance that covers their whole period staying in Korea prior to applying for HYU exchange/visiting student program. Financial Affidavit form with supporting documents (e.g., official e-Bank/Financial Statement) * Please note that we do NOT accept scanned copies, screenshots or unofficial copies. * For non-OECD nationals, Apostille verification or Consular authentication of the official enrollment and high school graduation certificates is additionally required. - For OECD nationals, students who only have the original high school graduation certificate may submit one of the followings instead: 1) Official graduation certificate or formal letter issued by the high school 2) Official high school final transcript that clearly indicates the graduation date 3) A copy of the diploma that has been apostille-certified - If the documents are translated documents, please submit both the original and translated versions as well.												

6. Academic Information

Credits and Study Load	1 HYU credit consists of 15 contact hours. Regular student's study load at Hanyang is 15~18 credits per semester while maximum credits are 20. Visiting students should take at least one regular course to maintain their D-2 visa. * Korean Language Course from the Hanyang IIE is not a regular course offered by HYU.																														
Course Registration	We try to open diverse list of English courses in various departments to visiting students. Visiting students are allowed to take courses from different departments <u>upon availability</u>. The most up-to-date course list becomes available a month prior to the beginning of semester. Until then, student should refer to the previous year's course list. (e.g. 2027 Spring semester applicant should refer to 2026 Spring semester course list) The previous English course list and information may be found from our course catalogue. Before coming to Korea, students will have several chances to register courses online. There are different phases for course registration categorized by their major and year and it works on "first-come, first-served" basis. The specific dates will be sent to students directly through email.																														
Departments with Limited Access to English-Taught Courses	Please note that the COLLEGE OF ART AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION as well as the COLLEGE OF MUSIC, offer very limited English-taught courses. In some semesters, there may be no English courses available at all. Additionally, practical or studio-based courses may also be difficult to register due to language barriers. We strongly advise exchange and visiting students to carefully consider this when selecting their majors.																														
Evaluation and Grade	Although the evaluation method may differ based on professor's policy, attendance is always an essential part of the evaluation process. Hanyang does not have re-sit examinations so the final grade inputted into the system cannot be changed. Students can take only one P/F course in one semester and most courses will be in letter grade. 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Transcript	Transcript becomes available approximately 3~4 weeks after the last day of semester. One (1) digital copy of transcript will be sent to student's email upon completion of program. A transcript for students who study at Hanyang for two (2) semesters will be sent to her/him only after the end of 2nd semester. Hard copy of transcripts may be sent on requests.
